- <u>Collegia Esperanza</u> provide funds, supplies and Christmas gifts for the students
- <u>Episcopal Refugee Network</u> food, clothing and other forms of support for individuals and families new to this country
- <u>Rachel's Center</u> Provides a safe, supportive environment and opportunities for women with few or no resources to gather, begin, and continue self-help efforts.
- <u>Peninsula Shepherd Senior Center</u> A community that honors, respects, and cares for older adults while empowering senior independence
- <u>Back to School Backpacks</u> In partnership with St. Mark's Episcopal Church in City Heights for San Diego's underserved children.
- <u>Interfaith Shelter Network</u>- dinners, lodging and other support for individuals making the transition to housing and employment
- <u>All Souls' Choristers Program</u> training in choral techniques, open to children, free
- Blessings in Bag, Episcopal Community Services, and more
